This Court, pursuant to the authority granted to it by section 21(c) of the Revised Organic Act of 1954, as amended, and title 4, sections 32(e), 32(f)(2), and 34(a) of the Virgin Islands Code, as well as its inherent authority, hereby proposes the following amendments to Supreme Court Rule 204, relating to the composition of the Virgin Islands Bar Examination. Accordingly, it is hereby

ORDERED that Supreme Court Rule 204(e) **SHALL BE AMENDED** in the following instances:

- Striking the phrase "Local Law Essay Examination" and inserting in its place the phrase "Multistate Essay Examination (MEE) and Multistate Performance Test (MPT) (collectively the 'Essay exam')"; and
- 2. Striking the phrase "day following the MBE exam" and inserting in its place the phrase "day before the MBE exam".

It is further

ORDERED that, pursuant to Supreme Court Rule 37, the public as well as members of the local Bench and bar **MAY SUBMIT WRITTEN COMMENTS** on these proposed amendments to the Clerk of the Court within thirty (30) days of entry of this order. It is further

ORDERED that, unless modified as a result of any submitted comments, the proposed amendments **SHALL TAKE EFFECT** on March 1, 2016, and commence with the July 2016
